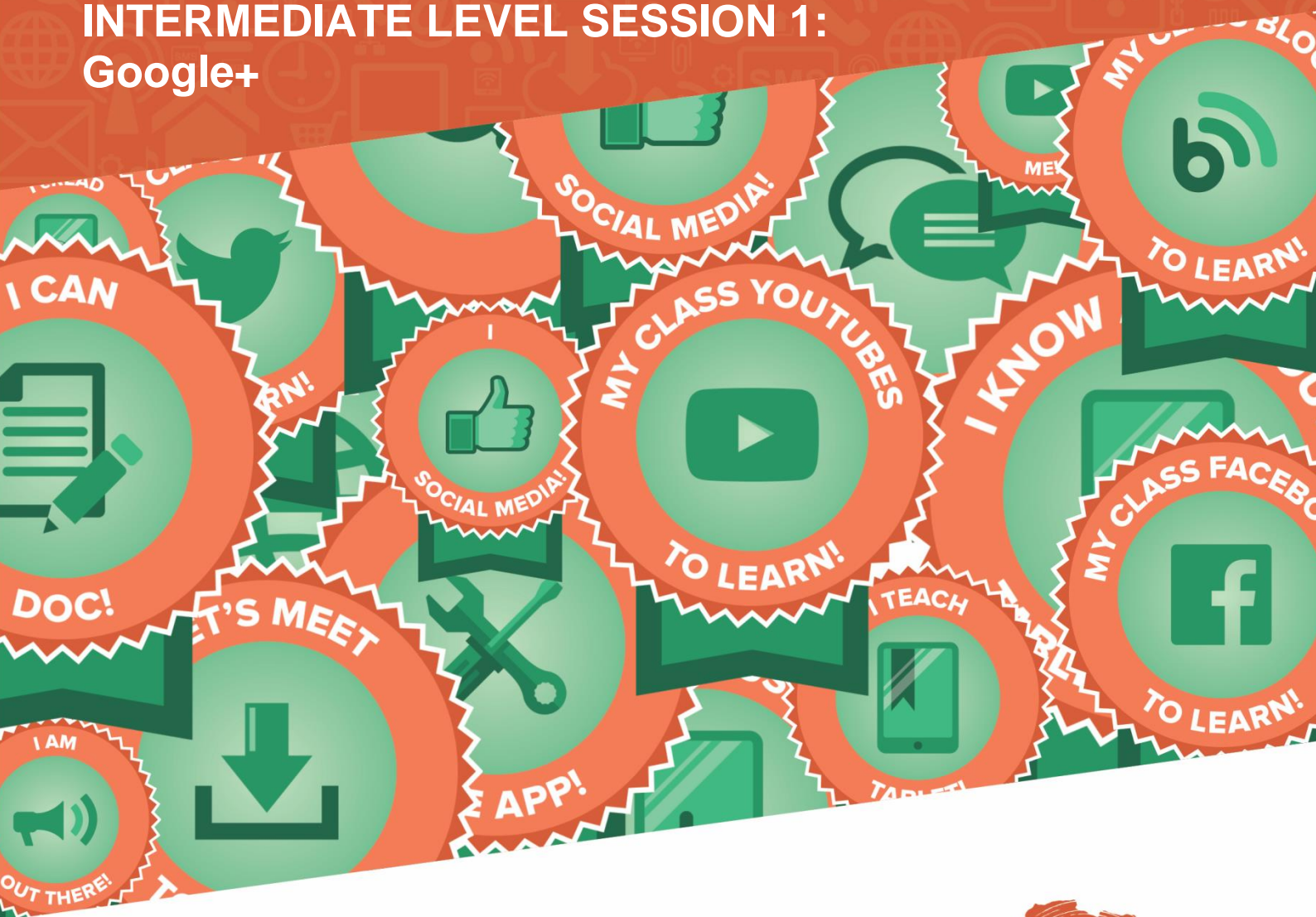

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Outcomes of the session

By the end of the session, participants will be able to:

1. set up and edit their Google+ profiles
2. find people they know and add people to their Google+ circles
3. customise their settings
4. share messages, photos or links on Google+
5. understand the value of Google+ communities in the classroom
6. join a Google+ community
7. use Google+ in the classroom
8. write a series of lessons incorporating Google +, check them against TPACK (Technological, Pedagogical and Content Knowledge), Bloom's Revised Taxonomy and SAMR (Substitution, Augmentation, Modification and Redefinition) and present their lessons to a class
9. email their lesson plans and what they have learned from the experience to their facilitator.

Content of the session

- Google+ (what it is, how to set it up, what to do with it)
- Constructing a lesson plan using Google+ and checking it against TPACK, Bloom's Revised Taxonomy and SAMR.

Activity

Create a series of lesson plans that incorporate Google+ for a grade or subject that you teach.

- Make sure that your lesson plans meet the requirements of the TPACK, Bloom's Revised Taxonomy and SAMR models.
- Teach these lessons to one or more of your classes.
- Email the lesson plans, as well as a reflection of the experiences of teaching these lessons, to your presenter. Use the following email address:

Your reflection should include:

- A short summary/overview of each lesson plan.
- How the implementation took place.
- Reflections/learning experiences commenting on TPACK, Bloom's Revised Taxonomy and SAMR.

You will be assessed on the following:

- The series of lessons (at least 3).
- The actual lesson plans (at least 3). You may use the lesson plan template provided in your Class Notes, but you are also free to use your own lesson plan template.
- The application of Google+ in your lessons.
- The application and reflection of TPACK in your lessons.
- The application of Bloom's Revised Taxonomy in your lessons.
- The application of SAMR in your lessons.
- Your overall reflection on each lesson in the series of lessons.



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
